- (2) This list is not for the use of Clinical Mental Health Counseling students looking to fulfill their 10-session requirement for their degree program. The counseling division has separate requirements for their students and we kindly ask that you do not use this list.
- (3) For the convenience of Denver Seminary students, the Student Life Department provides this list of area counselors/therapists who have indicated to the Seminary that they are willing to offer their services to Seminary students at a reduced cost.
